

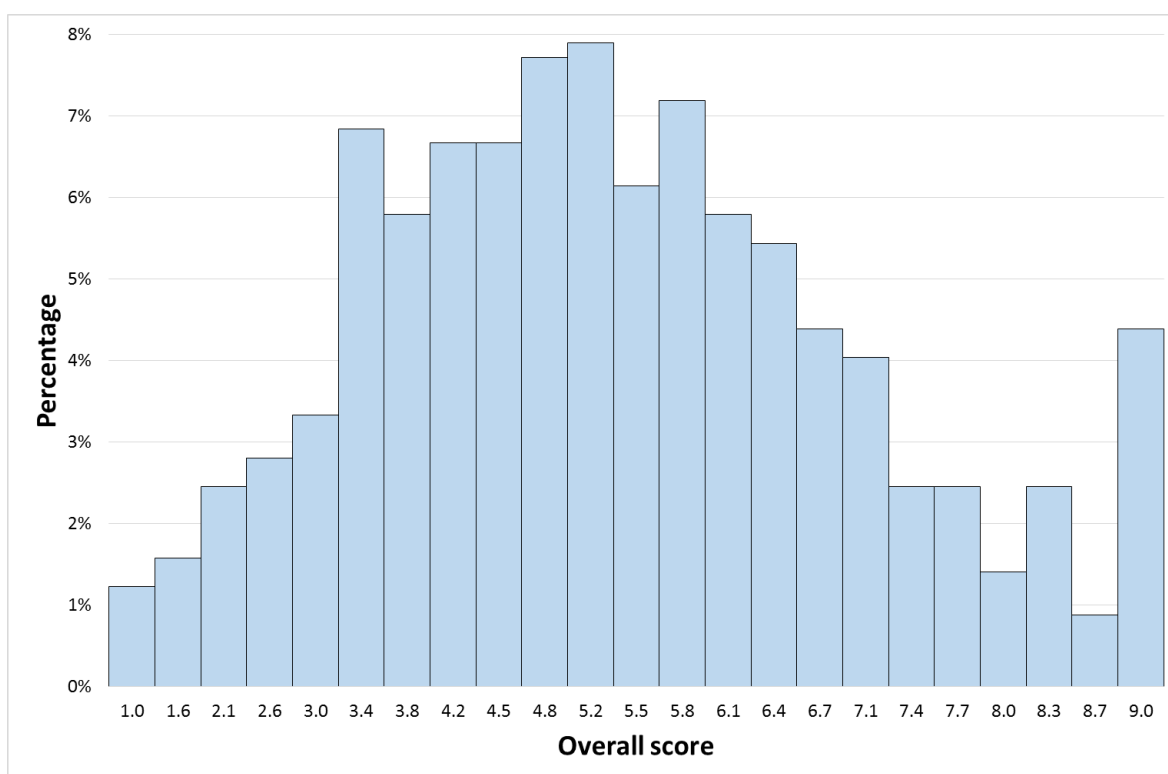
## Test of Mathematics for University Admission (TMUA) Explanation of Results

Results for TMUA are reported on a scale that runs from 1 (low) to 9 (high), with scores being reported to one decimal place. Candidates who do not respond to any items receive a score of 0.

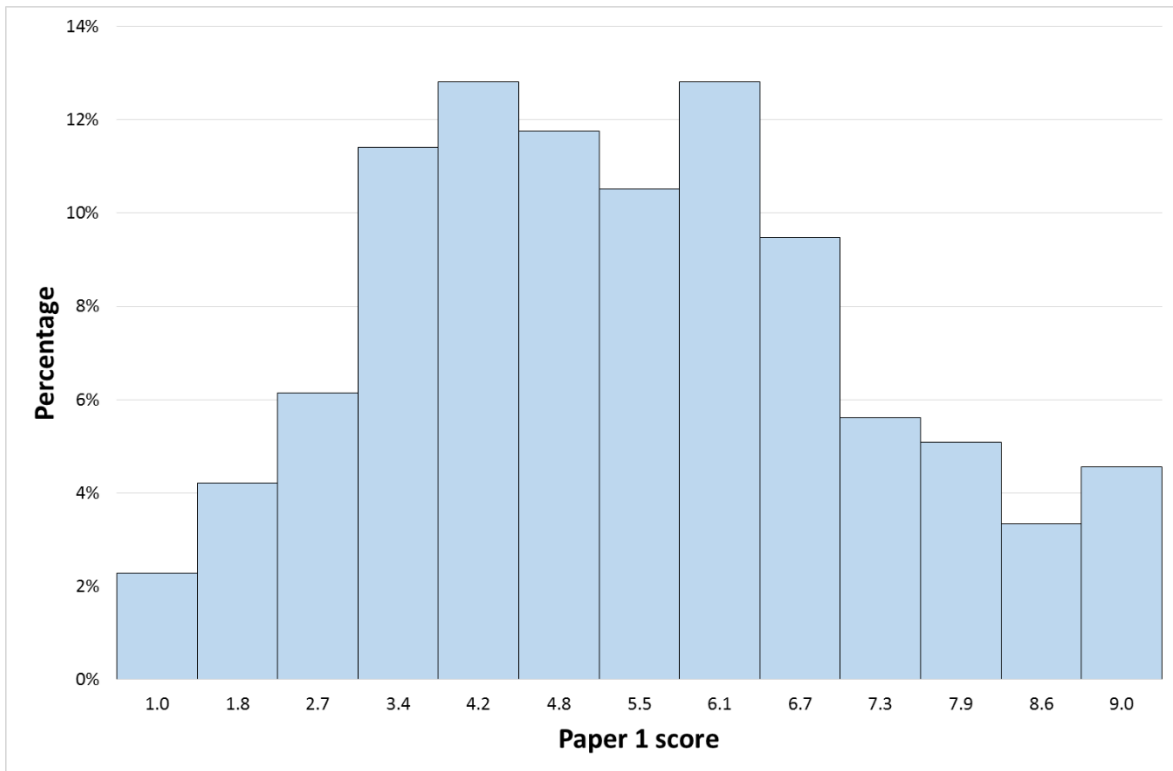
The scale has been designed so that approximately 50% of candidates will achieve overall scores higher than 5.0. In addition, approximately 10% of applicants will achieve overall scores higher than 7.5.

The distribution of the 2016 TMUA scores, overall and for Papers 1 and 2, are shown below.
