



Natural Sciences Admissions Assessment Explanation of Results

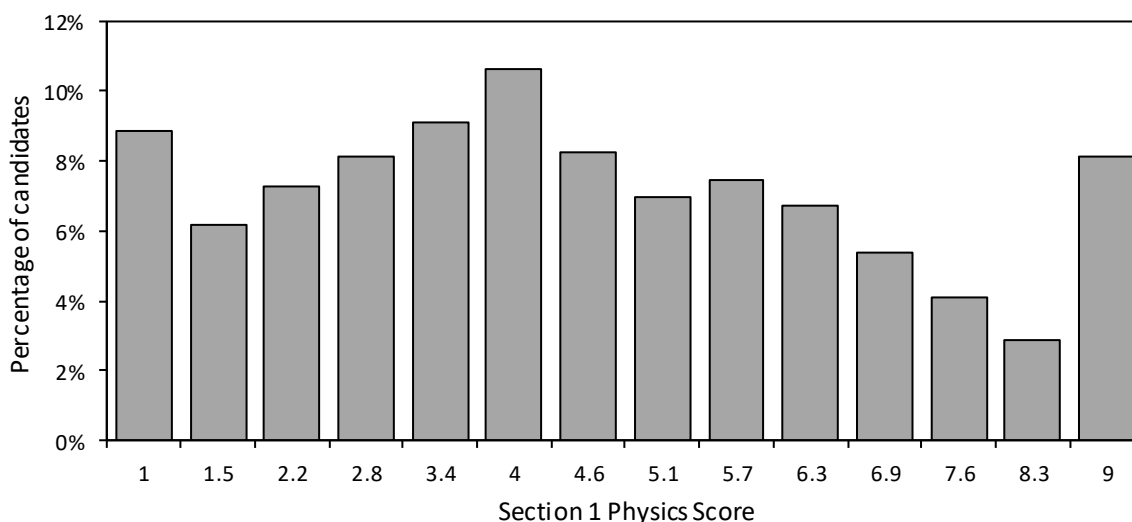
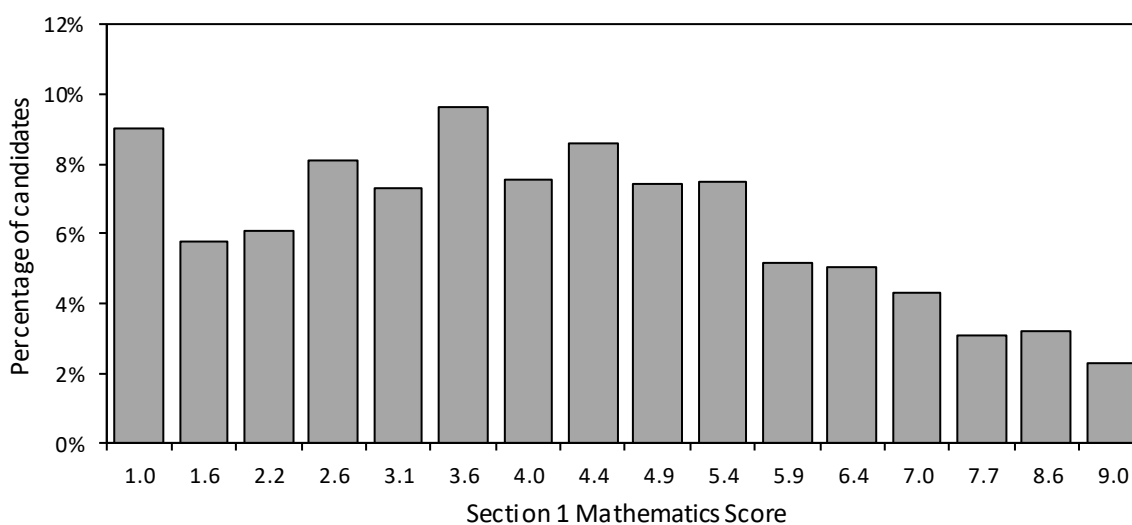
Results for the Natural Sciences Admissions Assessment are reported on the Cambridge Suite scale, which runs from 1 (low) to 9 (high). With scores being reported to one decimal place.

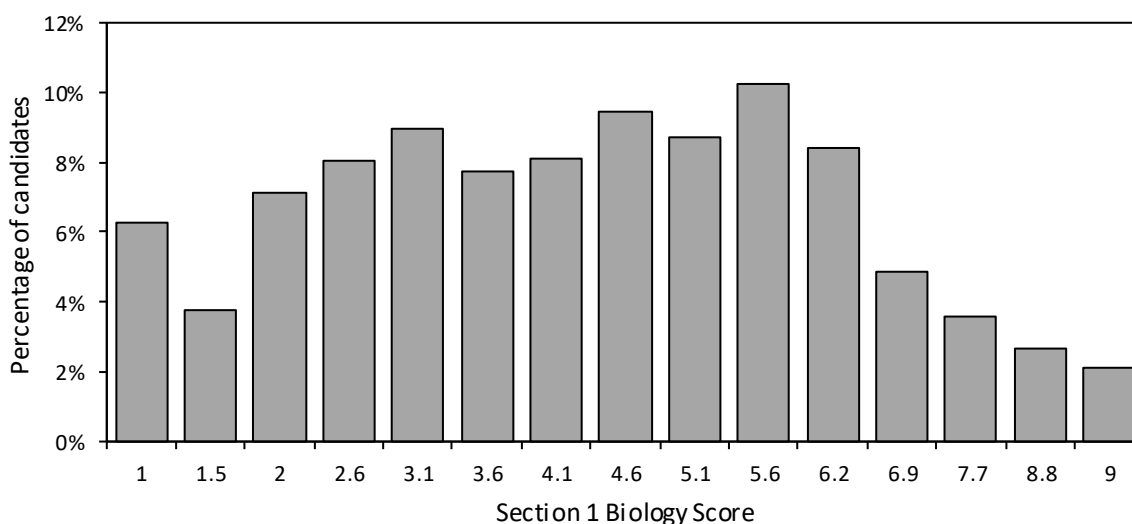
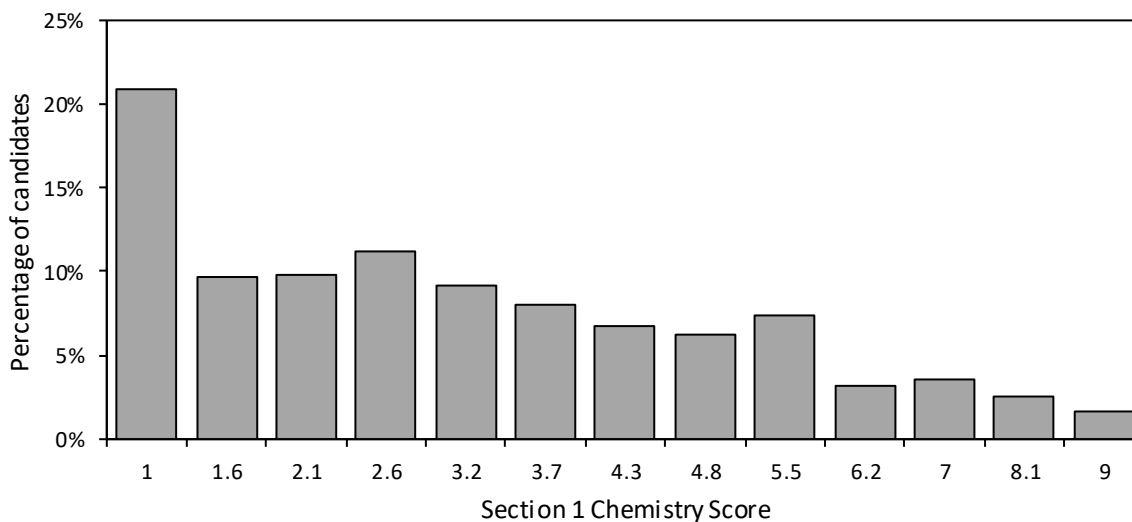
The scale has been designed so that typical applicants will score around 4.0. Approximately 10% of applicants will achieve scores higher than 7.0. Low scores are capped 1.0.

The distributions for the November 2021 Natural Sciences scores for Section 1 and 2 are shown below.

Section 1

Candidates are required to answer Part A: Mathematics plus one other part from Physics, Chemistry and Biology.





Section 2

Candidates are required to answer one part only from Physics, Chemistry and Biology.
